



Ideas to use the photos as visual prompts

- Use these as flashcards or conversation starters. You can pass them around, use them in small group activities, or have children match photos to descriptions of natural relationships.
- Create a sorting activity where children can sort the photos into categories like for example butterflies, birds
- Create small booklets with the real-life photos. These can be left in a reading/nature corner for the children to explore.
- Ask the children to look at the photos and draw something they observed.
- Create clipboards with the photos attached, allow children to take them outside to match with real-life examples they see in the garden or on a nature walk. This helps bridge the connection between the visual aids and real-world observation.
